## In 11 days, Gujarat purchases ₹1,177 cr groundnut crop on MSP

**With over 9.31 lakh farmers registered, this effort is part of a bigger plan to invest Rs 15,000 crore in various Kharif crops this season**

Gujarat government on Wednesday said that in the last 11 days, it has purchased ₹1,177 crore worth of groundnut on Minimum Support Price (MSP) from 70,000-odd farmers. Deputy chief minister Harsh Sanghvi on Wednesday said the government has bought 1.62 lakh tonnes of groundnut on MSP so far. Over 9.31 lakh groundnut farmers have registered with the state government for selling their Kharif produce on MSP. Gujarat had started procuring Kharif crops on MSP from November 9. businessline has already reported that Gujarat government will be buying ₹15,000 crore of various Kharif produce from farmers this season. This includes groundnut at ₹7,263 per quintal, moong at ₹8,768, urad at ₹7,800 and soybean at ₹5,328 per quintal.

The farmers in Gujarat have been adversely affected by unseasonal rains and a significant portion of the Kharif produce has been impacted. The government also announced two assistance package for the rain-affected farmers. On Wednesday, the government said more than 10 lakh farmers have registered with the government for aid under the ₹10,000 crore package declared earlier this month. In addition, another ₹1.25 lakh farmers have also registered for aid under the ₹1,138 crore compensation package declared for unseasonal rains during September 2025.
